

The Childress City Council met in Called Session Monday, January 3rd, 2022, at 12:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Childress City Hall, 315 Commerce St., Childress, TX 79201.

Public Comment

City Manager Kevin Hodges discussed the purchase of fleet vehicles with funds from General Fund with the Council. Work trucks for the field are needed, and sought Council opinion on an Administrative vehicle to use for daily work errands such as bank and post office as well as a vehicle to take on out of town training trips. Mr. Hodges advised he has purchased a 2022 Dodge Ram as a part of the Patterson Wichita Falls Fleet Program. This vehicle was purchased for \$35,695.09. Presented Council with potential fleet purchases of a second 2022 Dodge Ram (v6 at \$32,345.00 or v8 at \$36,436.64 depending on availability) and 2019 Ford Fusion for \$21,000.00 that would be paid from the General Fund.

Motion to proceed with the Fleet Vehicle purchase, to include either the v6 or v8 Dodge Ram and the Ford Fusion, or a comparable vehicle within \$21,000.00 range made by Alderwoman Johnson; Seconded by Alderman Preston. All Ayes.

With there being no further business, Council adjourned 12:26 p.m.
